DEFINITION OF A PEP

A domestic PEP is a person who holds - or has held within the last five years - a specific office or position in or on behalf of the Canadian federal government, a Canadian provincial government, or a Canadian municipal government. A person ceases to be a domestic PEP five years after they have left office.
